



WORK AND RESIDENCE VISA (AS AN EMPLOYEE)

Citizens from a non-European Union country wishing to reside and work in Spain must get a working contract and obtain the corresponding authorization to reside and work in Spain prior to applying for the visa. In order to process the visa, original and copy of the following documents must be presented:

- **National visa application form**, signed and filled out in print.
- **A recent full-face photograph**, in colour, on a light, plain and uniform background, without dark glasses or any garment that may prevent identification of the applicant.
- **Valid Passport** for a minimum of one year after the date of application.
- **Proof of residency in the Netherlands** (residence permit, working permit, study permit, etc.)
- **Authorization to reside and work in Spain.**
- Recent **medical certificate** issued by your family doctor stating: "*Mr/Ms... does not suffer from any illness that would pose a threat to public health according to the International Health Regulations 2005 (Este certificado médico acredita que el Sr./ Sra. ... no padece ninguna de las enfermedades que pueden tener repercusiones de salud pública graves de conformidad con lo dispuesto en el reglamento sanitario internacional de 2005, including COVID-19)*". If the certificate is issued in any language other than Spanish, certified translation into the latter.
- **A negative criminal record check**, issued by the authorities of the country or countries where you have lived during the past 5 years, including the Netherlands (in this country it is called VOG, and can be requested at the city council). This certificate cannot be older than three months.

All documents issued in any language other than Spanish must be translated into the latter. Both the original documents and the translations must be apostilled.

The processing fee for this kind of visa is 60€, and reciprocity fees may exist for certain countries, as is the case of the United States and Canada. The fee must be paid at the time of submitting the application.
