



NON-LUCRATIVE RESIDENCE VISA

If you wish to apply for a visa in order to obtain a temporal residence permit in Spain without carrying out a labour activity, original and copy of the following documents must be presented:

- **National visa application form**, signed and filled out in print.
- Form EX-01: Form must be signed and filled out in print. Only available in Spanish.
- Authorization form 790-052. Only available in Spanish.
- **A recent full-face photograph**, in colour, on a light, plain and uniform background, without dark glasses or any garment that may prevent identification of the applicant.
- **Valid Passport** for a minimum of one year after the date of application.
- **Proof of residency in the Netherlands** (residence permit, working permit, study permit, etc.)
- **Proof of economic means** enough to live in Spain without working. The minimum monthly income required is 2.130,04 € plus 532,51 € per each additional family member.
- **Proof of having accommodation in Spain, either owned or rented**, or proof of economic means enough to acquire it.
- Recent **medical certificate** issued by your family doctor stating: "*Mr/Ms... does not suffer from any illness that would pose a threat to public health according to the International Health Regulations 2005 included COVID-19.* If the certificate is issued in any language other than Spanish, certified translation into the latter.
- **A negative criminal record check**, issued by the authorities of the country or countries where you have lived during the past 5 years, including the Netherlands (in this country it is called VOG, and can be requested at the city council). This certificate cannot be older than three months.
- **Proof of health insurance** with international coverage, for both the applicant and accompanying family members.

All documents issued in any language other than Spanish must be translated into the latter. Both the original documents and the translations must be apostilled.

The processing fee for this kind of visa is 60€ and the residence authorization fee is 10,50€. Reciprocity fees may exist for certain countries, as is the case of the United States and Canada. The fees must be paid at the time of submitting the application.

Temporary residence visa for spouse and children of Non-Lucrative Residence Visa applicant.



In order to apply for a temporary residence visa for the spouse and children of a Non-Lucrative Residence visa applicant, **original and one copy** of the following documents must be presented, for each one of the applications:

- **National visa application form**, signed and filled out in print.
- Form EX-01: Form must be signed and filled out in print. Only available in Spanish.
- Authorization form 790-052. Only available in Spanish.
- **A recent full-face photograph**, in colour, on a light, plain and uniform background, without dark glasses or any garment that may prevent identification of the applicant.
- **Proof of family relationship**. Marriage and/or birth certificates, with Apostille or legalised.
- **Valid Passport** for a minimum of one year before the intended date of arrival in Spain.
- Proof of residency in the Netherlands (residence permit, working permit, study permit, etc.
- Recent **medical certificate** issued by your family doctor stating: "*Mr/Ms... does not suffer from any illness that would pose a threat to public health according to the International Health Regulations 2005 (Este certificado médico acredita que el Sr./ Sra. ... no padece ninguna de las enfermedades que pueden tener repercusiones de salud pública graves de conformidad con lo dispuesto en el reglamento sanitario internacional de 2005)*". If the certificate is issued in any language other than Spanish, certified translation into the latter.
- **ONLY FOR ADULTS (+18 years of age): NLY FOR ADULTS (+18 years of age): A negative criminal record check**, issued by the authorities of the country or countries where you have lived during the past 5 years, including the Netherlands (in this country it is called VOG, and can be requested at the city council). This certificate cannot be older than three months.

All documents issued in any language other than Spanish must be translated into the latter. Both the original documents and the translations must be apostilled.

The processing fee for this kind of visa is 60€ and the residence authorization fee is 10,50€. Reciprocity fees may exist for certain countries, as is the case of the United States and Canada. The fees must be paid at the time of submitting the application.
