

The Consulate General of Spain in Houston, after the restart of the AA flight number 36, Dallas - Madrid, would like to inform American Airlines and its passengers the following:

*Passengers who are able to enter in Spain, according to current regulations:

- Spanish nationals
- Legal residents in Spain
- Passengers granted with a Long term Visa (Type D)
- Spouses, parents or descendants of Spanish nationals
- Health professionals
- Good transport personnel on the practice of their duties
- Diplomats, international officials, military personnel and members of humanitarian organizations on the practice of their duties

*Transit passengers in Madrid airport:

- Passengers returning to their residence countries inside the Schengen area (Andorra, Austria, Belgium, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Sweden and Switzerland).
- Passengers returning to their residence countries granted with a long term Visa issued by a country from the Schengen area.
- Passengers traveling to their countries who have a layover in Spain, as long as they do not require an airport transit visa and have an operational and immediate connecting flight to their final destination, and with a layover no longer than 24 hours.(ex. Chinese citizens).
- Under any circumstances passengers who have a layover in Spain, will be allow to leave the international area of Barajas airport.

*Passengers traveling for humanitarian, necessity or force majeure reasons, will need to submit documentary evidence, 48 hours in advance, to the Consulate General of Spain in Houston (cog.houston@maec.es), explaining the exceptional reasons of their trip, in order to obtain their authorization to enter the country from the competent authorities in Spain.

*We kindly request to all passengers not included in any of the previous categories, to check in advance and with enough time, with the Consulates of Spain in USA, the possibilities to enter in Spain.
