

Medical Travel Insurance

Every applicant has to submit **proof** of medical travel insurance covering the **entire length** of your stay in Europe when applying for a Schengen visa.

The following requirements must be met:

- Total coverage of and for Sanitary Assistance, Accidents, Emergencies, Repatriation for medical purposes and death.
- Coverage of insurance has to be at least 30,000 EUR or its equivalent in USD **and valid for all the Schengen States**. Policies with deductible or Copayment will not be accepted.
- The policy must **clearly** specify the amount of coverage or state the coverage limit. Likewise, coverage for medical repatriation and return of remains, no co-payment/deductible must be **clearly stated**. The deductible must be \$ 0 (zero dollars).
- For proof of insurance, only a confirmation issued by the health provider will be accepted, outlining the required coverage and that the deductible is (0) zero.

Insurance Providers

The following list of providers of medical insurance for travel abroad is not exclusive and does not represent a recommendation by the Consulate General of Spain. You can find additional insurance companies in your local Yellow Pages or on the internet (search for "health insurance Schengen visa"). Please bear in mind that some companies offer medical insurance policies only in combination with other kinds of coverage like trip cancellation. Rates depend on the length of the trip, age and number of travellers and the extent of coverage.
