



VISA FOR FAMILY MEMBERS OF EU NATIONALS WHO REQUIRE A VISA TO ENTER SPAIN (OR WHO INTEND TO RESIDE IN SPAIN)

Australian passport holders **do not require a visa** for this purpose. However they must still provide the information listed in points 1, 4 and 5 below at border control.

If they wish to reside in Spain or stay over the permitted time frame they must register within the first 30 days of arrival into Spain at the Spanish Foreigners Office (Oficina de Extranjeros/local police) in order to apply for their residency card.

Foreign documents to be presented must be stamped with the Apostille of The Hague for recognition in Spain and these must be officially translated into Spanish. This can be obtained by contacting Australian Legalisation services (Department of foreign Affairs) and an accredited translator (NAATI).

Travellers requiring a visa must apply at the Consulate of their place of residency. [here](#)

To apply at this Consulate General you must be a **RESIDENT** in Victoria, South Australia, Western Australia or Tasmania.

Each application must include:

- 1- Passport with a validity of at least 6 months, and one blank page plus a photocopy of the details page of the passport. Please include a photocopy of your valid Australian residency visa (VEVO).
- 2- ONE visa application form duly completed and signed. [Application form](#)
- 3- Two passport sized colour photograph on a white background. Photographs must be printed on quality photographic paper.
- 4- Copy of confirmed flights **showing joint travel with EU partner**. Please note that the visa will be issued for these dates.
- 5- Proof of relationship (marriage certificate, family book, registration by a recognised official authority of their legal de-facto relationship and any other documentation to support the relationship. **It is important that your relationship is registered with the EU country of your family member. Please contact the respective Consulate or Embassy of that country for information.**
- 6- Visas are issued FREE OF CHARGE when presenting all required documents.

This family member category includes: officially registered spouse of EU national, children or partner's children who are financially dependent.
