



NON LUCRATIVE RESIDENCE VISA

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

1. 2 National visa application forms, duly filled out, signed by the person in who's name the will be issued, and 2 recent passport size photographs in colour and with white background attached to the form.
2. In case of representatives, power of representation. A photocopy of the same must be submitted.
3. Payment of Visa fees must be done through demand draft only in favour of CONSULATE GENERAL OF SPAIN MUMBAI.
4. Covering letter explaining the purpose of the visa application, translated to Spanish. A photocopy of the same must be submitted.
5. Proof of payment of the fees for the residence application procedures (Form Modelo 790, code 052).
6. Application form for authorisation of Residence (Form EX 01).
7. Passport with a minimum validity of 1 year and photocopy of all pages of the same.
8. Public or private medical insurance policy issued an insurance company authorised to operate in Spain. The medical insurance policy must cover the entire period of stay in Spain, the medical expenses and repatriation associated with an accident or sudden illness. A photocopy of the same must be submitted.
9. Police Clearance Certificate updated, translated to Spanish and legalised, issued by the competent authorities of the country where the applicant has resided in the last 5 years prior to the submission of the visa application. (Only in case of applicants who are above the criminal age of responsibility). In case of India, this certificate must be issued by the Regional Passport Office and must bear the stamp of Apostille of Hague issued by Ministry of External Affairs, India.
10. Medical certificate issued by any registered medical practitioner updated and translated to Spanish. The Medical Certificate must state the following phrase: ***“the applicant is not suffering from any disease that can have repercussions any on the public health in accordance with the International Sanitary Act 2005.”*** A photocopy of the same must be submitted.
11. Proof of sufficient economic means to support the living and stay expenses, including, the expenses of the family for the proposed duration of stay and without performing any labour or professional activity.
12. Original document that justifies the family bond relationship with the family members of the applicant, translated to Spanish and legalized. A photocopy of the same must be submitted.

13. Documents of school admission in Spain of the minors who are the dependents of the applicant.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS AND OBSERVATIONS

TRANSLATION: Translation to Spanish and legalisation of the translation of the documents presented (except passports).

PHOTOCOPIES: Kindly note that for each original document presented a photocopy of the same must be submitted. The photocopies must be made after legalising the translations and/or the documents.

INTERVIEWS: At any time during the visa application procedure, this Consulate General may require the personal appearance of the applicant, and if considered necessary, conduct a personal interview.
