### **RESIDENCE VISA FOR CAPITAL INVESTMENT**

- a) Unlisted shares or social participations: Declaration of the investment made in the Registry of Foreign Investment of the Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness.
- b) Investment in listed shares: Certificate of the financial intermediary, duly registered in the National Securities Market Commission (Comisión Nacional del Mercado de Valores) or in the Bank of Spain, in which it is mentioned that the applicant has made an investment to the effect of this norm.
- c) Public debt: Certificate of the financial organisation or the Bank of Spain, in which it is mentioned that the applicant is the sole holder of the investment for a period equal to or more than 5 years.
- d) Investment in Fixed Deposit: Certificate from the financial organisation in which it is mentioned that the applicant is the sole holder of the fixed deposit.

### **RESIDENCE VISA INVESTOR REAL-ESTATE PROPERTY**

- a) Certification with information from the Real Estate Registry that corresponds to Real Estate property or properties.
- b) Deed of Sale accrediting the investment in a Real Estate property of 500,000 Euros free of all tax, charges or obligations

### **RESIDENCE VISA INVESTOR COMPANY PROJECT**

- a) Favorable Report (Informe favorable) issued by the Economic and Commercial Office of Spain, Mumbai

### **RESIDENCE VISA FOR ENTREPRENEURS**

- a) Favorable Report (Informe favorable) issued by the Economic and Commercial Office of Spain, Mumbai



### **RESIDENCE VISA FOR HIGHLY QUALIFIED PROFESSIONAL**

- a) Authorization of work and residence permit for highly qualified professionals.

### **RESIDENCE VISA FOR TRAINING/RESEARCH**

- a) Authorization of work and residence permit for training/research.

### **RESIDENCE VISA FOR INTRA-COMPANY TRANSFER**

- a) Authorization of work and residence permit for intra-company transfer.

### **RESIDENCE VISA FOR FAMILY MEMBERS**

- a) Authorization of residence permit  
b) Justification of family relation bond of the applicants

### **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED**

1. 2 National visa application forms, duly filled out, signed by the person in who's name the will be issued, and 2 recent passport size photographs in colour and with white background attached to the form.

2. In case of representatives, power of attorney. A photocopy of the same must be submitted.

3. Payment of Visa fees must be done through demand draft only in favour of CONSULATE GENERAL OF SPAIN MUMBAI.

4. Passport with a minimum validity of 1 year and photocopy of all pages of the same.

5. Police Clearance Certificate updated, translated to Spanish and legalised, issued by the competent authorities of the country where the applicant has resided in the last 5 years prior to the submission of the visa application. (Only in case of applicants who are above the criminal age of responsibility). In case of India, this certificate must be issued by the Regional Passport Office and must bear the stamp of Apostille of Hague issued by Ministry of External Affairs, India.

6. Public or private medical insurance policy issued by an insurance company authorized to operate in Spain.

**- Not required for visas for highly qualified professionals, researchers and for intra-company transfer.**

7. Proof of sufficient economic means to attend to the living expenses, including if applicable, to the expenses related to his/her family, during the intended period of stay in Spain, and without practicing any professional activity.

**- Not required for visas for highly qualified professionals, researchers and for intra-company transfer.**

### **OTHER REQUIREMENTS AND OBSERVATIONS**

**TRANSLATION:** Translation to Spanish and legalisation of the translation of the documents presented (except passports).

**PHOTOCOPIES:** Kindly note that for each original document presented a photocopy of the same must be submitted. The photocopies must be made after legalising the translations and/or the documents.

**INTERVIEWS:** At any time during the visa application procedure, this Consulate General may require the personal appearance of the applicant, and if considered necessary, conduct a personal interview.
