



**VISA FOR FAMILY MEMBERS OF EU NATIONALS WHO INTEND TO RESIDE IN SPAIN  
AND REQUIRE A VISA TO ENTER.**

All documentation presented must be officially translated into Spanish

Australian passport holders **do not require a visa** for this purpose. However they must still provide the information listed in points 1, 3 and 5 below within the first 30 days of arrival into Spain at the Spanish Foreigners Office “Departamento de Extranjeria, Oficina de Extranjeros” and have registered at the “Ayuntamiento” in order to apply for their residency cards. All documentation must be officially translated into Spanish.

Passengers requiring a visa must apply for their visa at the Consulate of their country of legal residence

To apply at this Consulate General you must be a **RESIDENT** and reside in New South Wales, Queensland or Northern Territory.

Each application must incorporate:

- 1 - Passport with a validity of at least 6 months, and at least one blank page plus 1 photocopy of the details page of the passport and photocopy of the valid Australian residency visa.
- 2 - ONE visa application form, duly completed (**Scroll down for the Application Form**).
- 3- One passport size colour photograph on a light coloured background, this must be glued (not stapled) to the visa application form on the top right hand corner. Photographs must be printed on quality photographic paper.
- 4 - Copy of airline tickets (this is required to date the visa according to the date of entry)
5. Proof of relationship (marriage certificates, libro de familia, register at a public authority of a legal de-facto relationship and any other proof to support the relationship. It is important that your relationship is registered (if possible) with the EU country of your family member. Please contact the Consulate or Embassy of that country for information on this. Official Australian Government issued certificates such as birth and marriage certificates should be stamped with the Apostille of the Hague through the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

The visa issued will be valid for entry into Spain, within the first 30 days of arriving, you must register (empadronar) at the local “ayuntamiento” and then apply for a residency card at the Police “Oficina de Extranjeros”.

Such data as well as data concerning the decision taken on my application or a decision whether to annul, revoke or extend a visa issued will be entered into, and stored in the Visa Information System (VIS)<sup>1</sup> for a maximum period of five years, during which it will be accessible to the visa authorities and the authorities competent for carrying out checks on visas at external borders and within the Member States, immigration and asylum authorities in the Member States for the purposes of verifying whether the conditions for the legal entry into, stay and residence on the territory of the Member States are fulfilled, of identifying persons who do not or who no longer fulfil these conditions, of examining an asylum application and of determining responsibility for such examination. Under certain conditions the data will be also available to designated authorities of the Member States and to Europol for the purpose of the prevention, detection and investigation of terrorist offences and of other serious criminal offences. In Spain, the authority responsible for processing the data is the consular post at which the visa was applied for.

I am aware that I have the right to obtain in any of the Member States notification of the data relating to me recorded in the VIS and of the Member State which transmitted the data, and to request that data relating to me which are inaccurate be corrected and that data relating to me processed unlawfully be deleted. At my express request, the authority examining my application will inform me of the manner in which I may exercise my right to check the personal data concerning me and have them corrected or deleted, including the related remedies according to the national law of the State concerned. The national supervisory authority of that Member State [in the Spanish case, the *Agencia Española de Protección de Datos*; calle Jorge Juan 6, 28001 - Madrid (Spain) – [www.agpd.es](http://www.agpd.es)] will hear claims concerning the protection of personal data.

I declare that to the best of my knowledge all particulars supplied by me are correct and complete. I am aware that any false statements will lead to my application being rejected or to the annulment of a visa already granted and may also render me liable to prosecution under the law of the Member State which deals with the application.

I undertake to leave the territory of the Member States before the expiry of the visa, if granted. I have been informed that possession of a visa is only one of the prerequisites for entry into the European territory of the Member States. The mere fact that a visa has been granted to me does not mean that I will be entitled to compensation if I fail to comply with the relevant provisions of Article 6(1) of Regulation (EC) No 399/2016 (Schengen Borders Code) and I am therefore refused entry. The prerequisites for entry will be checked again on entry into the European territory of the Member States.
