RETIREMENT VISA

First you need to send all the requirements by email (cog.washington@maec.com) once we review everything we offer you an appointment to come in person to the Consular Section with all the originals and copies:

ORIGINAL AND ONE PHOTOCOPY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

1. National **Visa application** form
2. 1 passport size **photo** with a white background (Walgreens, CVS, or similar)
3. **Passport** issued in the last ten years and valid for a minimum of six months. If you are not US citizen you will have to provide us with your Green Card and a copy. **B1/B2 holders do not qualify to apply for a visa in this Consulate office.**
4. **Federal or State Police Report** where the applicant has spent six months or more during the past year. This document it must have the **Hague Apostille**. Please contact the Secretary of State of the state you live in for further information.
5. **Medical Certificate** typed on doctors stationary verifying that the applicant is in good mental and physical health and it is free of contagious diseases. **The document must be signed by the doctor. This document needs to be translated into Spanish and with less than 90 days.**
6. **Proof/s that you have sufficient financial means to live in Spain without working. It could be a certificate of a public or private institution certifying that you receive a pension, specifying its monthly or annual amount.**
7. Proof of **any other source of income and/or properties in Spain** if applicable.
8. **Health Insurance.** Proof of health insurance coverage while in Spain. We do not accept insurance cards. We need a letter from your insurance stating that you will be covered in Spain 100% and for one full year.
9. If you have already a **place to live or a lease agreement**, you should support your application with any documents you may have.
10. PREPAID EXPRESS ENVELOPE from USPS.
11. **There are two different fees, a visa fee and a residency permit fee (Money Order or exact cash only-EMBASSY OF SPAIN):**

**US citizens - \$140 non refundable.
Non US citizens \$97 non refundable.
Residency Permit Fee.- \$ 13**
