"Pass The Ball" is a **charitable** initiative designed at targeting disadvantaged **African** youth through football development and donation of equipment.

There will be two main components of the project:

- Getting coaches from LaLiga to come and assist developmental structures in selected African countries through coaching programs - Coach the Coaches.
- Ball donation events in certain cities of certain African countries where a number of balls will be given out to these communities – Durable balls.

The Ball

The accessibility to durable long lasting equipment for Sports is an issue that pans across the African continent.

The idea to **donate balls** is to give underprivileged kids access to them which will allow them to continuously play hopefully inherently leading to other community benefits such as teaching children team work, encouraging them to participate in sports, keeping them from committing crime, etc.

- The ball essentially will be the hallmark of the project and will include the following characteristics:
 - A LaLiga no name brand manufactured ball
 - A ball that can withstand the African terrain
 - A ball that is durable and long lasting

(Important to note: The ball that will be used for the pilot launch of the project will be a regular ball and will not have the characteristics indicated above)





LaLiga will source and bring the best coaches to teach the local coaches certain methodologies that will improve the football standard of the communities.

The intention of coaching local coaches is that it will reach more kids than just having a clinic that will only benefit a limited number of players.

The LaLiga coaches selected for the program will have the following skills:

- Top Level Experience
- Be proficient in English
- Have high empathy
- Able to manage large numbers of student coaches
- Have patience and a calm attitude
- Be fun and energetic





SAFA – Local Football Association

- LaLiga has partnered with SAFA for the #PassTheBall project as LaLiga and SAFA already have an established relationship and when it comes to football related matters pertaining to soccer donations it is imperative to always involve the local federation
- When giving out the soccer balls, LaLiga will pass the balls onto SAFA and they will immediately, live on television, give the balls to the coaches and children.

#Passtheball Pilot Launch

- As the project is still in it's infant stage, a pilot launch of the project will be taking place in Johannesburg and Cape Town
- The pilot will launch in Johannesburg will be on Friday the 23rd of February and will end in Cape Town on Friday the 2nd of March
- 3500 balls produced for this event will be distributed to children and coaches as part of the launch
- Following which, a two and a half day training camp will take place in both cities





Location of Clinic and Launch

The Launch and clinic will be taking place in Alexandra Township during the Johannesburg leg of the trip:

Alexandra

A township in the Gauteng province of South Africa. It forms part of the city of Johannesburg and is located near the Sandton. Alexandra is one of the poorest urban areas in the country. Alexandra is situated on the banks of the Jukskei River. In addition to its original, reasonably wellbuilt houses, it also has a large number (estimated at more than 20,000) of informal dwellings or "shacks".






Proposed Venue: Altrec Sports Complex

The venue is situated in the Alexandra township in Johannesburg and has a hall capable of gathering one hundred coaches to do the methodological classes instructed by the coaches and very good installations for interactive classes. The field has flood lights and a well maintained pitch for on field activities.

The Stellenbosch venue is still to be confirmed.










Location of Clinic and Launch Cont.

During the Cape Town leg of the trip, the clinic and launch will be taking place in Kayamandi, a Township located in Stellenbosch:

Stellenbosch

A town in the Western Cape province of South Africa, situated about 50 kilometres (31 miles) east of Cape Town, along the banks of the Eerste River at the foot of the Stellenbosch Mountain. It is the second oldest European settlement in the province. Kayamandi is one of the Developing Townships situated in Stellenbosch, Kayamandi is a soccer loving community with more than 20 teams, most of them playing informal soccer


Three Year Cycle


LaLiga Legacy Project #passtheball
