



Family grouping with EU nationals

Due the Spanish law, citizens from countries other than Turkey must submit all the documents in Spanish. In some cases, if necessary, it could be applied to Turkish citizens once their file has been examined. Be sure to bring a photocopy and original of all documentation. All documents issued by non-Spanish authorities must be translated into Spanish and duly legalized with the stamp of the Apostille of The Hague. The visa is free in all cases.

- 1.- Visa application (Spanish/English) fulfilled.
- 2.- One biometric photograph with white background.
- 3.- Photocopy of the passports of the spouses (only pages with data).
- 4.- Marriage certificate "FORMUL B" and photocopy (this certificate should be at most three months old and must be stamped with the Apostille of The Hague) translated into Spanish and a photocopy. The marriage must be registered in the Civil Registry of Spain or any EU country.
- 5.- Written application of the EU citizen resident in Spain expressing his/her wish that his/her spouse or relative live in Spain.
- 6.- In the case of regrouping the parents of the spouse, you must also present the birth certificate (maximum three months old) and all documentation that shows economic dependence of the applicant for the last year.
- 7.- In the case of regrouping a descendant of the spouse (children), you must also present the birth certificate (maximum age of three months) and the tribunal's decision stating that the applicant holds the legal rights of the minor.

EU citizens (non Spanish) living in Spain should also provide the following:
- 8.- Residency card of the EU citizen spouse.
- 9.- Other documents that show his/her links to Spain:
10.- *Certificado de empadronamiento* or EU citizens' registry in the *Subdelegación del Gobierno*
11.- Household bills of the last months.
12.- Any other that proves regular residence in Spain.
- 13.- Certificate of the National Authorities of the EU citizen' country stating clearly that the marriage is recognized as valid according to the national legislation.
- 14.- Flight reservation.
