



Residence visa for entrepreneurs and their internationalization

Due the Spanish law, nationals from countries other than Turkey must submit all the documents in Spanish. In some cases, if necessary, it could be applied to Turkish citizens once their file has been examined.

It is important to note that the processing of this type of visa lasts around two weeks.

It is essential that the holder of the passport come to apply and to take his / her visa personally.

It is not necessary that the original passport stays in the Embassy, it can be withdrawn. The procedures for the visa can be done just with a copy of the passport (every page). In the case of approval, the visa will be issued when the applicant comes to collect it with the original passport.

The applicant must also meet the requirement of not being irregularly in Spanish territory.

| 1.- Passport or travel title recognized as valid in Spain, with a minimum validity of one year. It must be accompanied by a photocopy of the biographical page. The passport or travel document must have been issued no more than 10 years before the scheduled date of the trip. Passports or renewed travel documents whose first issue took place more than 10 years ago are not accepted. The passport or travel document must have at least two blank pages. Visibly impaired passports or travel documents, damaged in whole or in part, with any of its pages peeled or torn or that do not have a magnetic reading band will be rejected. If you have any doubts about it, we recommend that you renew your passport. | |
| 2.- Visa application (Spanish/English) fulfilled. | |
| 3.- An updated passport-size photograph in color, looking straight, with a white background, attached to the application form. | |
| 4.- Certificate of criminal record, in the case of an applicant over 18 years of age, issued by the authorities of the country of origin or the country or countries in which he or she has resided during the last five years. This certificate must show that the person has not been sentenced for offences included in the Spanish Penal Code. It should be completed with the Apostille of the Hague or legalization according to the country (original and photocopy). | |
| 5.- Documentation that allows to verify the perception of periodic and sufficient income or the possession of a patrimony that guarantees this perception of income, with a minimum of 2,130.04 euros per month for the applicant and 532,51 euros per month for every family member at his/her charge, during their residence in Spain (original and photocopy). | |
| 6.- Public or private health insurance agreed upon with an insuring entity authorized to operate in Spain (original and photocopy). | |
| 7.- Foreigner Identity Number (NIE) (original and photocopy). If you do not have a NIE, you must request it at the time of submitting the visa application. To do this you must submit the Model 030 duly completed. | |
| 8.- To complete the payment of the visa application. | |
| 9.- Do not appear as rejected in the territorial space of countries with which Spain has signed an agreement | |

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: Depending on the case, it will be necessary to present the following additional documents (original and photocopy):	
Capital investors:	
<p>10.- They must prove that they have made any of the following investments in a period not exceeding 60 days prior to the submission of the application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Initial investment for a value equal to or greater than 2 million euros in Spanish public debt securities. It will be credited with the certificate from the financial institution or the Bank of Spain stating that the applicant is the sole owner of the investment for a period equal to or greater than 5 years.• Initial investment for a value equal to or greater than 1 million euros in unlisted shares or social participations of Spanish companies. It will be accredited with the copy of the investment declaration made in the Foreign Investment Registry of the Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness.• Initial investment for a value equal to or greater than 1 million euros in listed shares. It will be accredited with the certificate of the financial intermediary, duly registered in the National Securities Market Commission or in the Bank of Spain, stating that the interested party has made the investment.• Initial investment for a value equal to or greater than 1 million euros in bank deposits in Spanish financial institutions. It will be credited with the certificate of the financial institution in which it is established that the applicant is the sole holder of the bank deposit.	
Investors in real estate:	
<p>11.- They must present the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Documents proving that the applicant has acquired real estate in Spain with an investment of 500,000 euros or more for each applicant. The property must have been acquired after the entry into force of the law. This amount must be credited to each applicant and must be free of any charge or encumbrance.• Certification of the corresponding Property Registry, issued within 90 days prior to the presentation of the visa application, with the continuous information of ownership and charges. If at the time of the request, the acquisition of the property is in the process of registration, it will be sufficient to present the certification of the Property Registry in which the entry of the document of acquisition is valid, accompanied by the document accrediting the payment of the corresponding taxes.	
Entrepreneurs / Investors:	
<p>12.- They must submit a report from the Economic and Commercial Office of the area of geographical demarcation where the investor submits the visa application (Istanbul) in which it is found that in the business project they intend to undertake, there are reasons of general interest.</p>	
Highly qualified professionals:	



<p>13.- They must present a residence permit for highly qualified professionals previously processed in the Large Companies and Strategic Collectives Unit of the General Directorate of Migrations.</p>	
Researchers	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• They must prove that they fall within one of the following assumptions:• Research personnel referred to in article 13 and the first additional provision of Law 14/2011, of June 1, on Science, Technology and Information.• Scientific and technical personnel that carry out scientific research, development and technological innovation work in business entities or R & D & I centers established in Spain.• Researchers admitted in the framework of an agreement by public or private research organizations.• Teachers hired by universities, organs or centers of higher education and research, or business schools, established in Spain.• Workers who make intra-company movements within the same company or group of companies:• They must present a residence authorization previously processed in the Large Companies and Strategic Collectives Unit of the General Directorate of Migrations.	
<p>Relatives of the above:</p> <p>14.- The spouses of any of the foregoing can apply for a residence visa of this type, provided they meet with them or accompany them, and children under 18 years of age or older who are not objectively able to provide for their needs due to their health.</p> <p>15.- They must provide documentation proving the family link (marriage or birth) with the Apostille of The Hague (Original and photocopy) or legalization according to the country.</p>
