



Student visa (more than 90 days)

Due the Spanish law, nationals from countries other than Turkey must submit all the documents in Spanish. In some cases, if necessary, it could be applied to Turkish citizens once their file has been examined.
It is important to note that the processing of this type of visa lasts around two weeks.
It is essential that the holder of the passport come to apply and to take his / her visa personally.
It is not necessary that the original passport stays in the Embassy, it can be withdrawn. The procedures for the visa can be done just with a copy of the passport (every page). In the case of approval, the visa will be issued when the applicant comes to collect it with the original passport.

1.- Valid passport or travel title, recognized as valid in Spain, with a minimum validity for the entire period for which the visa is requested. A photocopy of this document will be attached.

2.- Application form (Spanish / English) filled in.

3.- A biometric picture with white background.

4.- **For stays longer than 180 days:** Police Certificate issued by the authorities of the country of origin or the country or countries where the person has been residing for the last five years. This certificate must show that the person has not been sentenced for offences included in the Spanish Penal Code (with photocopy, translated into Spanish and legalized with the stamp of The Hague convention).

5.- **For stays longer than 180 days:** Medical certificate (translated into Spanish and legalized with the stamp of The Hague convention) In the certificate it must be clearly stated that the applicant does not suffer from any kind of illness that could generate severe repercussions on public health according to the 2005 International Sanitary Regulations.

6.- The letter of invitation or admission in a public or private educational center, officially recognized, to study or extend studies or to carry out research or training work, in which it must include, the code number assigned to said center in the National Registry of Universities, Centers and Teaching or in the State Register of non-university educational centers, both under the Ministry of Education and Science, as well as the research centers recognized as such by the Ministry of Industry, Tourism and Commerce or by the Ministry of Education and Science. This letter must be written in Spanish or legalized according to the country.

7.- Copy of ID (in Turkey, the Kimlik kartı).

8.- The study agreement between universities and / or officially recognized educational entities, in Spanish or translated into Spanish, signed by the three parties.

9.- Kind of studies that you already have (specifying the title in its case), bring your diplomas and certificates

10.- Proof of the payment of the fees of the educational center.



11.- The content of the study, training or research plan to be carried out.	
12.- Travel insurance IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT INSURANCES: Insurances in which policy it is stated that there is a limit of 90-92 days will not be accepted. We suggest, to avoid delays that the applicant makes sure that the insurance is valid throughout the stay in Spain (Please bear in mind that sometimes, even if it is written 180 or 365 days, policies are limited to 90 or 92 days. These Insurances are NOT accepted). Under no circumstance two consecutive insurances will be accepted, only one insurance will be submitted and it must be valid for the whole stay in Spain.	
13.- Proof of having enough means, (personally or supported by your family) bank accounts with movements of money for the last year and pay slips from the parents.	
14.- Address in Spain: rental agreement, hotel booking...	
15.- In case of minors it is necessary the written permission of the parents.	
16.- In case of training mobility it is necessary the "training agreement" signed by the three parties, in Spanish or translated into Spanish.	
17.- Flight reservation: in case of a stay shorter than 180 days it must be round trip in case of a stay longer than 180 days it can be just one way	
18.- If it is a temporary displacement of minors for schooling under article 93 of the Immigration Regulations, original of the previous favorable report of the Delegate or Sub-Delegate of the Government in the corresponding province.
