



### VISA FOR INTERNSHIP PURPOSES:

Applicants are informed that the visa application procedure for non-work internships has been modified.

Applicants who want to do non-work internships in Spain (NOT STUDIES) who are studying or have finished their studies in the last 2 years, have to apply for the PCA / PCP \* visa.

To this purpose the company that has signed the agreement / contract to carry out these practices (hotels, law firms, etc.) should go to the corresponding immigration office in his area, to request a residence permit for practices (Law 14/2013 of support for entrepreneurs and their internationalization) for the student.

When this resolution is obtained in Spain, students must make an appointment at the Embassy to personally request the corresponding PCA / PCP visa. To do this they must provide the following documentation:

- Valid passport with a minimum validity for the period for which the residence is requested.
- Copy of the passport biometric sheet.
- Criminal records issued by the countries in which you were residing in the last 5 years. They must be duly translated into Spanish and legalized. The legalization in Turkey, Azerbaijan is carried out through the Hague Apostille. Applicants from third countries should ask us how to proceed to legalize the documentation.
- Copy of the residence permit for practices mentioned above.
- Cash payment of the visa fee (USD 68).
