



Supporting documents to request a visa for loss, theft or expiration of the residence card	
1.- Application form (original and photocopy) fulfilled with capital letters, and signed by the passport holder. In case of minors, it must be signed by the person exercising parental authority or legal guardianship. (LINK WITH THE APPLICATION FORM)	
2.- Two biometric photographs.	
3.- Passport or travel document and photocopy of all pages of the passport. The applicant's passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the scheduled start of the trip. In any case, and as an additional proof, provide previous passports where visas are issued.	
4.- In case of theft or loss, original and photocopy of the report to the police, a copy of the card or supporting document that has residence in Spain or return authorization.	
5.- If you are the holder of a residence card in Spain under the General immigration regime , you can go to the Embassy to submit an application, under previous appointment. You must present what is established in points 1, 2 and 3. 6.- If you are the holder of a residence card in Spain under the Family regime of EU / EEA / SWITZERLAND citizen , you will also need a previous appointment to apply for a visa with which you can return to Spanish territory. You must present what is established in points 1, 2 and 3. In case of theft or robbery, also a photocopy of the report to the police, in case of expiration, also a photocopy -if available- of the document proving residence in Spain . 7.- Document justifying having a sponsor or having accommodation: Invitation or guarantee provided in the national legislation (Note: there is more information and links to the downloadable forms on the websites of the Embassies and Consulates of the Member States).
