



Self-employment visa

This visa application is processed in two phases. In the first phase, an authorization is requested from the Spanish authorities. Once the authorization has been granted, the applicant must apply for the entry visa.

You are requested to carefully check the [general terms for submission of Spanish national visas](#).

The applicant should come personally to the Embassy of Spain without appointment (check [our address and opening hours](#)). A consular fee must be paid in Indian rupees via draft issued in favor of Embassy of Spain when submitting a long-stay visa application. Since consular fees are set out in euros, they are subject to change. Please check our updated [list of consular fees](#).

Application for an authorization

- Form EX 07 (*Solicitud de autorización de residencia temporal y trabajo por cuenta propia*) duly filled and signed by the applicant. The form can be downloaded [here](#).
- One copy of the pages of the passport with biographic data (in the case of an Indian passport, at the beginning and the end).
- All the relevant permissions or licenses to set up and develop the projected professional activity
- Proof of professional qualification sufficient to carry out the activity, including, if applicable, the official registration.
- Detailed plans of the projected activity, including foreseen investment, expected profits and, if applicable, number of jobs created.
- Proof of availability of the funding required for the projected activity.
- Form 790 (code 052) duly filled and signed by the applicant. The form can be filled [here](#).
- Form 790 (code 062) duly filled and signed by the applicant. The form can be filled [here](#).

Application for the entry visa

- One application form for national visa properly completed (full postal address, email address and telephone should not be omitted), dated and signed in blue ink. The visa application form is free of charge and can be downloaded [here](#). One photograph not older than 6 months of the applicant, 35-45 mm, on a white background, should be affixed on the application form.
- Passport of the applicant with at least two blank pages, valid for at least four months.
- Original criminal record certificate(s)¹ of the countries where the applicant has resided for more than 6 months in the previous 5 years. If the applicant has resided in India, the criminal record certificate or Police Clearance Certificate must be issued by the regional passport office. Criminal record certificates are only valid for 3 months from the date of issuance.
- A copy of the former document(s).
- Original medical certificate 1 issued by any chartered medical doctor stating that the applicant does not suffer from any disease that might have a severe impact on public health in accordance with the [International Health Regulations \(2005\)](#). This document is valid for 3 months from date of issuance.
- A copy of the former document.

¹ Public documents (criminal record, marriage, birth certificates) must be submitted either with the Hague apostille or duly legalized and accompanied by an [official translation](#).
