



Study visa (more than 90 days)

You are requested to carefully check the [general terms for submission of Spanish national visas](#).

You will find here below the documents required to submit an application for a long-stay visa that will entitle you to:

- undertake studies in Spain in a full time program conducive to a diploma or a certificate of studies
- undertake unpaid research activities or participate in a student mobility programme and later on join a secondary education and/or baccalaureate programme in an officially recognized educational centre
- carry out unpaid training in an institution either public or private
- participate in a voluntary service scheme which pursues aims of general interest

The applicant should come to the Embassy of Spain without appointment (check [our address and opening hours](#)) and submit the application in person. A consular fee must be paid in Indian rupees via draft issued in favor of Embassy of Spain when submitting a long-stay visa application. Since consular fees are set out in euros, they are subject to change. Please check our updated [list of consular fees](#).

Documents

- One application form for national visa properly completed (full postal address, email address and telephone should not be omitted), dated and signed in blue ink either by the applicant or, should she/he be a minor, by both parents. The visa application form is free of charge and can be downloaded [here](#). One photograph not older than 6 months of the applicant, 35-45 mm and with a white background, should be affixed on the application form.
- Passport of the applicant with at least two blank pages, valid for the entire duration of the envisaged stay in Spain.
- One copy of the pages of the passport with biographic data (in the case of an Indian passport, at the beginning and the end).
- Evidence of sufficient economic means to cover all the expenses related to the envisaged stay in Spain: tuition fees, accommodation and livelihood (estimate for 2019 is 537.84 euros per month) and return air ticket. The applicant may alternatively prove that some of these expenses have been fully paid in advance. ITR for last 2 years and original bank statements for last 6 months can be used as proof. If the applicant participates in a student mobility programme, a commitment by the organization to assume full financial responsibility for the student can be considered as proof of economic means.
- Medical/health insurance from a public or private insurance provider authorized to operate in Spain.

Specific documents for different purposes

Studies

- Original letter issued by an authorized education centre in Spain of admission in a full-time programme conducive to a qualification/diploma or certificate of study. One copy of the letter must be also submitted.

Research or training purposes

- Original letter of admission issued by a centre in Spain officially authorized to carry out such activities. In the case of research, such centre should be a University, a centre belonging to the Spanish Council for Scientific Research, or other public or private R&D institution. One copy of the letter must be also submitted.

Student mobility programme

- Original admission letter from an officially recognized secondary education and/or baccalaureate school or research centre. One copy of the letter must be also submitted.
- Acceptance on a student mobility programme, offered by an organization officially recognized for that purpose.

- Evidence that the organization assumes responsibility for the student throughout their period of stay, particularly with regard to their study fees, living expenses, and return trip to their country.
- Evidence that the student has accommodation during their stay with a host family or institution chosen by the organization conducting the programme.

Unpaid training

- Original acceptance letter issued by or agreement with either a public or private company, or officially recognized professional training centre. One copy of the letter must be also submitted.

Voluntary service programme

- Submission of a signed agreement with the organization that runs the program. The agreement should include a description of the activities and conditions for undertaking them, programme, financial resources available to cover the costs of the trip, sustenance, and accommodation throughout the stay. One copy of the agreement must be also submitted.
- Evidence that the organization has taken out civil liability insurance for their activities.

Specific documents if the duration of the course is more than 180 days

- Original criminal record certificate(s)¹ of the countries where the applicant has resided for more than 6 months in the previous 5 years. If the applicant has resided in India, the criminal record certificate or Police Clearance Certificate must be issued by the regional passport office. Criminal record certificates are only valid for 3 months from the date of issuance.
- A copy of the former document(s).
- Original medical certificate 1 issued by any chartered medical doctor stating that the applicant does not suffer from any disease that might have a severe impact on public health in accordance with the [International Health Regulations \(2005\)](#). This document is valid for 3 months from date of issuance.
- A copy of the former document.

Specific documents in case the applicant is a minor (below 18 years)

- An express authorization in favor of an individual in Spain signed from either the parents of the applicant, the parent who has the sole custody of the minor or the legal guardian of the applicant.
- A copy of each parent's passport pages with biographical data (in the case of an Indian passport, at the beginning and the end), attested by notary public, unless the parent is present when submitting the application.
- If the minor applicant will be taken in by a family or an individual in Spain, the family or the individual must express, through an "Acta de Manifestaciones" authorized by Spanish Notary Public, an acknowledgement that the acceptance of the minor does not have adoption as the objective and commitment to favor the return of the applicant to his/her country of residence.
- Police clearance certificate issued by the Spanish authorities in favor of the individual in Spain, who has been authorized by the parents of the minor, stating that he/she does not have any police record of sexual nature against him/her.

Specific documents if any member of the family of the applicant is also applying

- Evidence of sufficient economic means to ensure accommodation, return air ticket and livelihood of the family member during the entire duration the applicant stay in Spain. Estimated livelihood cost in 2019 for the first accompanying family member is no less than 403.38 euros per month for livelihood; for additional family members, 268.92 euros per month per person. The applicant may alternatively prove that some of these

expenses have been fully paid otherwise. ITR for last 2 years and original bank statements for last 6 months can be used as proof.

In the case of spouse/registered partner

- Marriage certificate¹ (in English), issued by a civil registry or registry of marriages.
- A copy of the former document.

In the case of children below 18 years

- Birth certificate¹ (in English), issued by a civil registry or registry of births and deaths.
- A copy of the former document.
