



FEE FOR SHORT TERM VISA

When submitting an application, a consular fee must be paid. The consular fee for a visa application is the equivalent in the local currency to 60 euros, and it is, therefore, subject to change. For certain categories of applicants, visa consular fees are waived or reduced (see below). Should a visa be refused, visa fees are non-refundable.

The visa fee for short term visas in Indian rupees is as follows:

	For adults	Children between 6-12 years	Children below 6 years

Exemptions:

Family members of EU/EEA/Swiss citizens:

Core family members of a citizen of the European Union, the European Economic Area (EEA) -Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein- and Switzerland who envisage a trip to Spain with them or to join them are exempted from visa fee. Core family members are:

- the spouse;
- the partner with whom the EU citizen has contracted a registered partnership, on the basis of the legislation of any Member State, if the legislation of the host Member State treats registered partnership as equivalent to marriage;
- children who are under the age of 21 or are dependant as well as those of the spouse or partner as defined above; or
- the dependant parents and those of the spouse or partner as defined above.

Other exemptions:

- School pupils, students, postgraduate students and accompanying teachers who undertake stays for the purpose of study or educational training.
- Researchers travelling for the purpose of carrying out scientific research as defined in Recommendation No 2005/761/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 28 September 2005 to facilitate the issue by the Member States of uniform short-stay visas for researchers from third countries travelling within the Community for the purpose of carrying out scientific research.
- Representatives of non-profit organisations aged 25 years or less participating in seminars, conferences, sports, cultural or educational events organised by non-profit organisations.
- Holders of diplomatic and service passports.

BLS:

When submitting an application through BLS, a service charge must be paid. There are no exemptions for this service charge. Should the applicant use some of the optional services offered by BLS, there might be voluntary, additional charges.

If you have a direct appointment at the Embassy:

Visa fee shall be payable only via bank draft at the Embassy of Spain. Payment of visa fee in cash is not accepted. Bank drafts will only be payable in favour of: **EMBASSY OF SPAIN.**
