Subject: Registration guideline for vaccination against covid-19 for foreign nationals residing or working in Bangladesh

- The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has decided to include foreign nationals residing or working in Bangladesh in the nationwide vaccination campaign against covid-19 in PHASES.
- Foreign nationals holding A/A1/A2/FA2/D/ND/M categories of visas will be considered for vaccination in the first phase (the visa must be valid for at least next 6 months)
- 3. Starting on 17 March 2021, the birthday of Father of the nation, Bangabardhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, a separate tab will be added in the surokkha.gov.bd portal for registration by foreign nationals.
- All foreign nationals holding valid A/A1/A2/FA2/D/ND/M visas should approach their respective embassies/ High Commissions/ Organizations to send their details to Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangladesh.
- To be included in the vaccination programme, the following information are required in Microsoft Excel Format:

- Starting 17 March 2021, the foreign nationals will be able to self register after 5 working days
 of sending the list through their respective embassies/High Commissions/ Organizations with
 relevant information provided in Excel sheet.
- Only after registration and receiving SMS in the mobile, the foreign nationals will be able to get vaccine in the centre selected during self registration.
