The Diplomatic Mission of Spain in Edinburgh has taken the decision to procure cleaning services for its premises. Therefore, it is with pleasure that I hereby invite you to submit a bid, under the terms stipulated in the **technical specifications** that you shall find attached, together with the applicable **draft contract**.

## Characteristics of the procurement:

Base budget of the tender (taxes included)	GBP 58,000. Any bid exceeding said amount shall be automatically excluded from the tendering procedure.		
Duration of the contract	24 months, with two extension of 12 months each.		
Civil liability insurance policy	A civil liability insurance policy is required for the minimum amount of the base budget of the tender.		
Guarantee	A guarantee is not required.		
Price review	There will be a price revision during the execution of the contract, throughout the processing of the extension, according to the accumulated monthly variation of the national Consumer Price Index between the start of the contract/extension and three months prior to the beginning of the extension (https://www.ons.gov.uk/economy/inflationandpriceindices).		
Award criteria	Price		
Conflict resolution	Any litigious issues arising from the performance of the contract shall be resolved by mutual agreement between the parties and, failing that, shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the Spanish courts, in the case of Spanish companies. In all other cases, these matters shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the Spanish Courts if the Contractor so accepts.		
Solvency requirements for	Economic and financial solvency:		
candidates	Civil liability insurance for professional risks for an amount equal to or greater than the base budget of the tender.		
	Technical and professional solvency:		
	List of the principal services or works carried out of the same or similar nature to that constituting the subject matter of the contract, within, at most, the last three years, stating the amount, the date and the recipient (whether public or private) thereof. The price of the aforementioned contracts should at least amount the base budget of the tender.
