

This grants programme offers civil servants and other public system staff from countries prioritized by the fifth Spanish Cooperation master plan the opportunity to **study an on site**Master's Degree in Spain over a ninemonth period.

Modalities

Any official Master's Degree offered by a Spanish university, representing up to 60 credits, which falls within one of the thematic areas prioritized by Spanish Cooperation

Master's Degree in the Teaching of Spanish as a Foreign Language for Filipino teachers

Master's Degree in Diplomacy and International Relations from the Diplomatic School of Spain (Development Cooperation module)

Before the start of the application period, the candidate must process the pre-admission in the destination center where the Master's Degree is to be given, in accordance with the requirements established by the same



Prerequisite

To be a national of one of the following countries according to selected modality: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Cape Verde, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Chile, Ecuador, Egypt, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Philippines, Equatorial Guinea, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Jordan, Mali, Morocco, Mauritania, Mexico, Mozambique, Nicaragua, Niger, Palestine, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Dominican Republic, Senegal, Tunisia and Uruguay.

To be a civil servant or other staff member of the public system of the candidate's country, including the personnel of the public education and university system, and have received authorization from the Government of their country of origin.

To have a knowledge of the language in which the Master's Degree is to be given.

Amount

- Monthly stipend up to €1,200
- Contribution towards travel costs up to €1,500
- Contribution towards enrolment fees up to €5,000
- Travel and accident insurance during their stay in Spain.
