

## **STANDARDIZED CERTIFICATE FOR HUNTERS**

The Consul General of Spain/Charger of Consular Affairs in Melbourne, pursuant to the provisions of Article 110 of the Weapons Regulations, approved by Royal Decree 137/1993, of January 29, CERTIFIES:

That Mr./Ms. , a national of [country name], expresses his/her intention to submit to the Civil Guard a request for special authorization to use weapons of categories 2º 2º (long rifled weapons for big game hunting) and/or 3º2º (shotguns) to temporarily engage in the practice of hunting, in accordance with art. 1101 of the aforementioned Regulation.

That, to prove his identity, he presents to this Consulate a passport issued by (country) no. , valid until .

According to said passport and other documentation provided, said citizen was born in (town and country), on the day and resides in (town and country).

For the purposes established in article 110.2, he also presents valid documentation that entitles the interested party to the possession and use of weapons of the categories indicated in the country of residence .
