Ambassador Iranzo has held the post of Deputy Head of Mission in Gabon, Mozambique and Algeria, as well as Consul General in Sidney (2013-2017).

- Israel (July 2008 - June 2012).
- Saudi Arabia (April 2017 - November 2021)
